

JOHN WESNER: (E'58,'68) He is presently an "Adjunct Fellow" in CMU's ICES (Institute for Complex Engineered Systems). Before coming to CMU in 2000 to share his many years of experience doing and leading Engineering Design, he worked for 31 years at Bell Laboratories on the physical design of communications products (like telephones). He has a BS and PhD in Mechanical Engineering from Carnegie, and an MS in MechE from Caltech. He recruited at CMU for Bell Labs for more than 20 years.

HENRY THORNE: (E'82,'84, TPR'00) Chief Technology Officer and co-founder of 4Moms. Creator of the Tug hospital delivery robot and the Origami Power Folding Stroller. Founder of the CMU Intramural Ultimate league.
